Oswego County DSS May Be Able to Subsidize Day Care Expenses Relating to the following:

- Work and/or Participation in Work Activities
- Attending an Approved School or Training Program
- Teen Parent Attending High School
- Physical or Mental Incapacity of Parent or Adult Caretaker
- Adults active on Temporary Assistance & Participating in Work Requirements
- Working Families Transitioning from Temporary Assistance

Eligibility Facts:

- Families with children age 12 or younger (over 12 with special needs)
- Income is at or below the maximum income level
- Family has an approved childcare need
- Family has an approved Provider
- Family has met all verification requirements

How to Apply:

- Apply online at ocfs.ny.gov
- Complete and file OCFS-6025 Child Care Assistance Application
- LDSS-2921 and Child Care attachments for Family Approval
- Complete the Registered/Licensed Provider Form
- Complete the Informal Provider Application Packet for Provider Approval (Friend or Family Member)

***IF Active TA:** contact your worker and verify employment, income and hours. Then complete the Registered or Informal Provider packet as outlined above.

What happens if you are approved?

- Choose a provider and enroll your child. You can choose any of the following types of care:
 - Licensed day care center • Registered family day care • Licensed group family day care
 - Registered school-age child care • Enrolled legally exempt child care provider
- You may have to pay part of the child care costs (family share copay) unless you are receiving public assistance, experiencing homelessness, when such assistance is provided as a protective or preventive service, when such assistance is provided to a child in foster care or when it is a child only case.
- As long as you continue in an allowable activity, you will remain eligible for CCAP for 12 months, unless your household income goes above 85% of the state median income.
