Are you eligible?

- You could be eligible if your income is less than the income eligibility level and you:
- Are receiving public assistance; or
- Work a minimum of 10 hours per week; or
- Are going to school or a vocational program; or
- Are seeking employment; and
- Your child is one of the following:
 - · Younger than 13
 - Younger than 18 with special needs; or
 - · Under court supervision
 - Younger than 19 in a secondary school; or equivalent program and has special needs
 - Younger than 19 in a secondary school; or equivalent program and under court supervision

How do you apply?

To apply complete the following steps:

- Contact your LDSS. https://ocfs.ny.gov/directories/
- Ask for a child care assistance application
- Complete the application and return it to your LDSS.
- You will need the following:
 - · Identification for everyone in the household (include proof of citizenship for each child)
 - · Income verification (paystubs or other documentation to prove employment and
 - Proof of residence
 - Work or school schedule
